Introduction, Overview and Important Dates 2018-19

Welcome New and Returning Band Members and Parents,

The 2018-19 Council Rock North Marching Band season is now underway! We are looking forward to an exciting and busy year with football games, competitions, parades, and concerts.

I trust you will find this overview of the color guard uniforms helpful. The Fall Tunic (Top half of the Color Guard Fall uniform) is provided to each student by the Council Rock Band Parents' Association as well as an insulated raincoat. During Mini Camp in June your student will be measured to help in sizing her uniform. During August band camp the Fall Tunic will be distributed. The Fall Tunic and rain coat will stay in the band room at all times. Like participants in other organizations in the Council Rock School District, such as orchestra, choir, and sports teams, our guard members and their parents will be asked to sign a Uniform and Equipment Agreement outlining their responsibilities for the Color Guard uniform. A copy of this agreement can be found in this packet. **Students and parents should take the time to thoroughly read through the agreement.**

In addition to the Fall uniform, the color guard also have a <u>summer uniform</u> which consists of black capri leggings and a navy-blue polo shirt with the CRNMB logo. This uniform is worn in warm weather during football season and for the Memorial Day Parade. *Each guard member must purchase the <u>polo shirt</u> from <u>kampusklothes.com</u> (Online Team Sales tab) crnmarchingbanduniforms18.itemorder.com/ between June 21 and July 1, 2018. Students will have an opportunity to try on polo shirts and samples of the black capri leggings during Mini Camp in June to determine their correct sizes. Please be sure your student takes advantage of this opportunity. All sales are final, and orders cannot be placed after the deadline. More details about the summer uniform and ordering can be found in this packet. The black capri leggings is a new addition to the summer uniform for the Color Guard and Mrs. Steyn will order them directly from Kampus Klothes. Payment of the black capri leggings is due when the order is placed. Pricing for the Black Capri Leggings can be found in the section titled Color Guard Uniform Distribution.*

In addition to the above summer uniform, guard members must also purchase one pair of black "Starlite 2" guard shoes, which are worn with the fall uniform and summer uniform. During Mini Band Camp in June, the students will have the opportunity to try on the guard shoes and order. Payment is due when the order is placed. Pricing for the black Starlite 2 guard shoes can be found in the section titled Color Guard Uniform Distribution.

Guard members need to purchase personalized track suits (pants and jacket). During Mini Band Camp in June the students will have the opportunity to try on samples of the tracksuit pants and track jacket that Mrs. Steyn will order directly from Kampus Klothes. Payment is due when the order is placed. Pricing for the personalized tracksuit pants and jacket can be found in the section titled Color Guard Uniform Distribution.

Guard members who has rifles and sabers assigned to them will need nude colored talon fingerless gloves. During <u>August Band Camp</u>, the students will have the opportunity to try on the gloves and order. Payment is due when the order is placed. Pricing for the gloves can be found in the section titled Color Guard Uniform Distribution.

Your student will need solid black ankle socks with no visible logos. These socks are worn with both uniforms and students will provide their own. We recommend buying at least two pairs.

Finally, please be sure students' names are clearly written in the Guard shoes, polo shirts, tracksuit pants and gloves. Remember that the <u>Guard shoes should be cleaned before every performance</u>. Be sure that the summer uniform polo shirt and black capri leggings are clean and wrinkle-free, ready to be worn whenever Mr. Bishop or Mr. Trimble asks for this uniform.

SUMMER UNIFORMS

- The summer uniform consists of black capri leggings, a navy-blue polo shirt with the CRNMB logo, Black Starlite 2 Guard shoes and black ankle socks. This uniform is worn during warm weather at the start of the football season and for the Memorial Day parade.
- Color Guard members must purchase the polo shirt from www.kampusklothes.com (Online Team Sales tab) between June 21 -July 1, 2018. There will be an opportunity to try on the polo shirts during Mini Camp on June 21 and 22, 5-6:00PM and 9-9:30PM, in the cafeteria. All sales are final, and items cannot be ordered after the July 1st deadline. They will be delivered to students on the first day of August Band Camp.
- Students are required to wear the black capri leggings from Kampus Klothes to guarantee a uniform look. You may not provide your own leggings.
- Students should provide their own solid black ankle socks with no visible logos.
- Guard shoes can be purchased during June Mini Band Camp. <u>Please have these shoes cleaned for every performance.</u>
- Musicians and Color Guard members are expected to have their summer uniform ready should the director call for them, which means the black capri leggings must be washed, guard shoes be cleaned, and the polo shirt laundered and wrinkle-free. **Please do not leave** the summer uniforms in the instrument closets in the band room.
- Be sure to clearly label all items with your name. We have very limited summer uniforms available to borrow from the guard uniform closet. Students who are not prepared may not be able to participate.

Suggested Care Guidelines for Summer Uniforms

- The black capri leggings can be machine washed cold with like colors. **DO NOT** bleach or add softeners. **DO NOT** iron and please **do not** tumble dry your black capri leggings.
- The polo can be tumbled dry on low and touched up with an iron set to synthetic if needed.
- Only non-chlorine bleach should be used on polos to maintain uniformity of color.
- · Fabric softener can be used on the polo shirts but will interfere with the wicking and cooling performance of the shirts.

Color Guard Uniform Distribution!

- Mr. Larry Trimble will distribute the Fall Tunic during August band camp. Proper washing instructions will be provided.
- The Fall Tunics will be numbered and recorded in each student's Uniform and Equipment Contract.
- Each student will be provided with a new or existing identification card which needs to be filled out or updated by the student.
- The identification cards need to be placed in the plastic pocket of your uniform garment bag.
- Guard shoes, black capri leggings, tracksuit pants and personalized track jackets will also be distributed during August band camp.
- Guard shoes need to be clearly labeled in the inside and be placed in the zipper pocket in the garment bag.
- The nude talon fingerless gloves for the rifle line will be ordered during the first week of August band camp and distributed the following week.
- Your Band Booster Fee and any outstanding fees are due the night you receive your Fall Tunic. Checks payable to CRBPA.

COUNCIL ROCK NORTH MARCHING BAND UNIFORM AND EQUIPMENT CONTRACT 2018-2019

All marching band uniforms and equipment are the property of Council Rock High School North and the Council Rock Band Parents Association. A portion of the Marching Band Booster Fee is allocated for the use of the uniform and its accessories, equipment, and related items, and <u>routine</u> uniform cleaning and maintenance during the 2018-2019 year and will be collected during fitting nights in August. If this fee is a financial hardship, please contact Mr. Bishop or Mr. Larry Trimble and the fee will be confidentially waived.

It is the responsibility of each student to properly care for the uniform, accessories, equipment, and related items. Individual students will be required to pay for the repair and/or replacement of the uniform, accessories, equipment, and/or related items in case of loss or damage due to neglect as determined by Mr. Bishop and Mr. Trimble.

My parent(s)/guardian(s) and I, ______, understand that I am solely responsible for any and all parts of the uniform and equipment issued by the Council Rock North Marching Band. I understand that if any parts of the uniform, accessories, equipment, or related items are lost or damaged, I will assume total responsibility for all repair and/or replacement costs. Failure to do so will result in a school obligation. I understand that the estimated costs are as follows:

My parent(s)/guardian(s) and I understand and agree to follow the uniform guidelines established by the Council Rock North Marching Band:

- 1. I will purchase the required color guard shoes. * I will keep these shoes clean, polished, and free of mud. I will also label the inside of each shoe with my name.
- 2. I will purchase the required gloves if I am assigned to rifles and sabers. * I will keep this clean by laundering them on my own as needed.

- 3. I will purchase the summer uniform (navy polo with the band logo and black capri leggings). * I will keep this uniform clean by laundering them on my own after each use. It will be ready to wear whenever the band director/guard director asks for this uniform.
- 4. I will purchase the required personalized color guard track suit jacket and pants. * I will keep this clean by laundering it on my own after each use.
- 5. I will purchase solid black ankle socks with no visible logos. * These socks will always be worn with both my uniforms. It is recommended that you buy 2 pairs.
- 6. To prevent damage/staining, I will not eat any messy food or drink any colored liquids when in uniform and or Rain Coat unless directed by a staff member.
- 7. I will not allow my uniform to come into contact with antistatic spray, spot cleaning chemicals, bleaches, spray deodorants, perfumes, make up, or hair care products such as hair gel or hair spray.
- 8. I will never iron or make alterations to any part of my uniform except for hemming. <u>If my uniform becomes dirty or</u> damaged, I will immediately bring it to the attention of one of the adult members of the color guard.
- 9. If my uniform gets wet, I will tell an adult with the guard and follow their instructions.
- 10. My uniform will NEVER be taken home, except in special circumstances (for hemming/washing in beginning of the marching band season) as determined by Mr. Larry Trimble.
- 11. I will treat my uniform with respect. This means taking it on and off with care, hanging it up **PROPERLY**, not laying it down on the floor or ground, and not sitting on the ground while wearing it.
- 12. After performances, my Fall Tunic and guard shoes will be checked in with the color guard parent and then returned to the proper place in the uniform closet in the band room. My Fall Tunic will be HUNG PROPERLY on its hanger and placed into my garment bag. My guard shoes will be stored in the zipper pocket of my garment bag. My black capri leggings will be taken home and washed according to the washing instructions. Please **DO NOT tumble dry the capri leggings**.
- 13. During performances I will wear my hair strictly according to Mr. Larry Trimble's instructions.
- 14. I will not wear jewelry with my uniform unless otherwise instructed by Mr. Larry Trimble.
- 15. My assigned rain coat will be hung in numerical order on the coat racks. This rain coat is not to be used during rehearsals unless directed by Mr. Bishop or Mr. Larry Trimble.
