#### HAWAII TRIP UPDATES

Thanks to all families for promoting Band Bingo and the Ford Drive 4 UR School fundraisers. We had about 100 Bingo players at Bingo night! The online store for Hawaii travel uniforms is now open. Please go to <u>https://crnmarchingbandfall2018.itemorder.com/sale</u>. Place your orders by the closing date, November 18, 2018. The expected delivery date for the clothing is December 19-20 at the Band's winter dress rehearsal and concert.

In Hawaii, the instrumental students will have an exchange concert indoors where they will wear their usual summer uniforms (khaki pants, CRNMB polo shirt, belt, calf high black socks, and Dinkles). Their THREE other performances will be at outdoor venues. For these shows they will wear a uniform consisting of khaki shorts, CRNMB polos shirt, sneakers (black, gray, or navy), and black ankle socks.

Color guard members will have 2 shows and will wear black capris and polo shirts for both performances.

Our recommendation is that each instrumental student has 2-4 CRNMB polo shirts, 2-3 khaki shorts, and 1 khaki pants for the trip. Color guard members should plan to have 1-2 capris and 1-2 CRNMB polo shirts.

In order to have a consistent look for all band members, the khaki shorts, CRNMB polos, khaki pants, and capris **MUST** be purchased online from Kampus Klothes. Boys will have the option of purchasing shorts with either 9" or 11" inseams. The shorts are made by the same company as the khaki pants so sizing should be similar.
