## Welcome to the Council Rock North Band Family

The Council Rock North Marching Band is a family of musicians and performers who work together to foster a spirit of teamwork, school spirit, and a passion for music and the performing arts. The marching band performs at Football Games, Band Competitions, Parades, and other community events. The friends you make in marching band may be some of your best friends throughout high school and beyond. The memories you make will stay with you forever!

During Band Camp, the marching band practices the basics of marching and playing while learning the music of the 2024 field show. ***BAND CAMP*** is the time when most High School Bands learn their show. ***These 2 weeks of rehearsal in August are mandatory for everyone on the team!*** The staff of the band creates a show that is uniquely suited to the members of the current band, including the drill formations that correlate to the music.

Each member of the band is KEY! ***There is no “bench” in the marching band!*** Every student is a starting player, a visual soloist, and an essential cast member needed to make the drill formations, music, and choreography that we perform. For that reason, we need all of our team here for EVERY rehearsal and performance!

In the fall, we work on refining and improving our 2024 production to make it the best it can be. We continue to perform at football games, but we also begin the band competition season. Band competitions exist to foster a spirit of camaraderie amongst the many bands, while offering performance opportunities that showcase our band members as the star attraction! This year, North is scheduled to compete in festivals and in USBands Competitions. Our Fall Sport of Marching Band usually concludes in early November, while our Concert Band, Indoor Color Guard, and Jazz Band continue all year!

***All Rehearsals and Performances are Mandatory.*** Check with your family now to make sure you are available. If there are any conflicts, have your parents notify Mr. Filosi in writing or

email him at [mark.filosi@crsd.org](mailto:mark.filosi@crsd.org). Our Band Family will receive timely updates on any changes to our rehearsals, performances, or protocols as we move forward. Again, attendance at performances is vital to our success!!!

### **SUMMER SECTIONALS**

**The North Marching Band performs weekly sectionals over the summer after July 4 until we reach BAND CAMP.** Our rehearsals will be held indoors at North unless otherwise noted. This information will be provided as we get closer to the summer. Your student section leader will organize these meetings. They will be held at CR North band Room every Monday between 12:00 and 5:00 PM (as organized by your section leader). They will be about 2 hours in length. We must be out of the building by 5 PM as that is when summer hours end for our building and maintenance staff.

Each of these rehearsals is not mandatory, but strongly encouraged as we get a head start into our season. This is our chance to dig into the music and to work on our marching skills prior to band camp. If you will be out of town on vacation, or have a pre-existing conflict, that is not a problem. To be early is to be on time, to be on time is to be late, to be late is WRONG!

**8:15 am**     **Conditioning and Stretching**

In this sport of the arts, we must prepare our bodies to be successful at marching and playing through basic calisthenics, light running and light stretching.

**8:30 am**     **Visual Basics**

This is where we perfect the art of marching and moving through space with our instruments. We cover Forward Motion, Backward Motion, Slide, Oblique, Flutter and Jazz Runs.

**10:00 am**   **Learn Drill**

Marching members are given a list of coordinates and page numbers and are taught how to find their place on the football field. We practice finding the coordinates of each "CHART" and we practice moving to and from each chart. Whenever possible, we learn any visual moves or choreography as part of this process. This is the most important thing we do in Band Camp!

**12:30 am**   **Lunch**

**1:30 pm**     **Music Sectionals** (*Flutes, Clarinets, Trumpets, etc.*)

Staff, Officers, and Section Leaders will lead you through our basic training exercises, show music, and stand tunes.

**2:30 pm**     **Music Full Ensemble** (*Horns, Percussion, Pit, Guard in Auditorium*)

The staff will guide rehearsals in order to put the larger sections of the band together.

**3:30 pm**     **Stand Tunes**

**4:30 pm**     **Fun Activity**

**5:00 pm**     **Dismissal** (It may take us about 15 minutes to put our equipment away at 5:00)

**Attendance Policy**

As mentioned before, attendance at rehearsals and performances are mandatory and is vital to the success of our organization. **Marching band is a registered class. Therefore, your final**

**grade will be dependent on your attendance at both.** Listed below are examples of what an excused and unexcused absence will look like. Unexcused absence at performances will result in a lowering of final grade for those registered for the class.

### **Excused Absences**

Severe or sudden illness or Injury that would prevent you from performing

School Absence (If you sign in late for school, you must be at rehearsal)

Weddings/Bar Mitzvahs (This must be given to me IN WRITING no more than 1 month before a performance)

Funerals/Sudden death in the family

College Visits (During rehearsals and seniors only, visits during performances will be unexcused) SATs (See Bottom of Page 11)

### **Unexcused Absences**

Sporting Events (AKA Phillies, Flyer, Eagles, Sixers...etc)

Celebrations (Birthday parties, anniversary parties, family picnics, etc)

Driving Tests

Work (please plan work around band, let your employer know your band schedule)

Recreational Travel (shore, family trips, concerts, etc)

Private Lessons (students are strongly encouraged to use Tuesdays for their private lessons)

Even if you are absent from school, we DO NOT have access to the absentee bulletin. We must be contacted through REMIND or EMAIL [mark.filosi@crsd.org](mailto:mark.filosi@crsd.org) for this to be excused.

If you sign in late you MUST be at rehearsal

If you sign out early, or go home ill when school ends, please have your parents Email me at [mark.filosi@crsd.org](mailto:mark.filosi@crsd.org) BEFORE rehearsal which begins promptly at 3:30 PM. Students should NOT call "student leaders or other band members" to relay messages to staff or this will be an unexcused absence

If you have a conflict in school (missed work, detention, etc) it is YOUR responsibility to inform us BEFORE the date in question.

Student leaders are NOT permitted to excuse ANYONE

In conclusion, we ask all parents and students to plan AROUND our band schedule. Unexcused absences will lead to a student being pulled from a performance, removed from the field show, or removed from the band entirely. Also, not knowing your work becomes a SAFETY issue for other students involved.

## **UNIFORMS**

The instrumentalists in the Marching Band program wear two uniforms. The traditional, Formal Uniform is worn during football games, some concerts and competitions. There is also a Summer Uniform that is worn during warm weather at the start of the football season and in the Memorial Day Parade in May. The majority of the marching band uniform is funded and provided by CRSD and the Council Rock Band Parent Association. There are, however, several items that instrumentalists are required to provide (at their own expense) to complete the marching band uniform. These are detailed and diagrammed below.

If purchasing any of the required uniform items presents a financial hardship, please contact the Band Director, Mr. Filosi, and the fees will be confidentially waived. There are also second hand components for sale at a discount.

Once the Formal Uniform is distributed, instrumentalists and their parents will be required to sign a Uniform and Equipment Agreement (similar to other organizations' requirements within CRSD). This Agreement outlines responsibilities and care for this marching band uniform.

Wearing a marching band uniform is both an honor and a privilege, but, at times, the process can seem a little overwhelming considering the many details involved with ordering, wearing and caring for the uniforms. The following overview will help guide you through the requirements; however, questions may also be directed to the Council Rock Band Parent Association Uniform Chairperson:

## **FORMAL UNIFORM**

- The majority of the Formal Uniform is ***funded and provided*** by CRSD and the Council Rock Band Parent Association (CRBPA). There are, however, a few elements in this uniform that each instrumentalist is responsible for providing at their own expense.
- ***Assigning*** the Formal Uniform items is a two-step process. Instrumentalists are measured in May during Mini Band Camp and then individual fittings and distribution take place in August during the first week of Band Camp.
- Each instrumentalist is issued a garment bag that holds the Formal Uniform jacket, bibbers and gauntlets. The garment bag is stored in the uniform closet in the band room. Shakos and plumes are also stored at school. Periodic cleaning of these items will be covered by CRBPA.
- Storage and cleaning of the navy blue performance tee/navy polo, white gloves, black socks, and polished Dinkles will be the ***responsibility*** of each instrumentalist for each performance.
- The formal uniform is inspected after each wear.

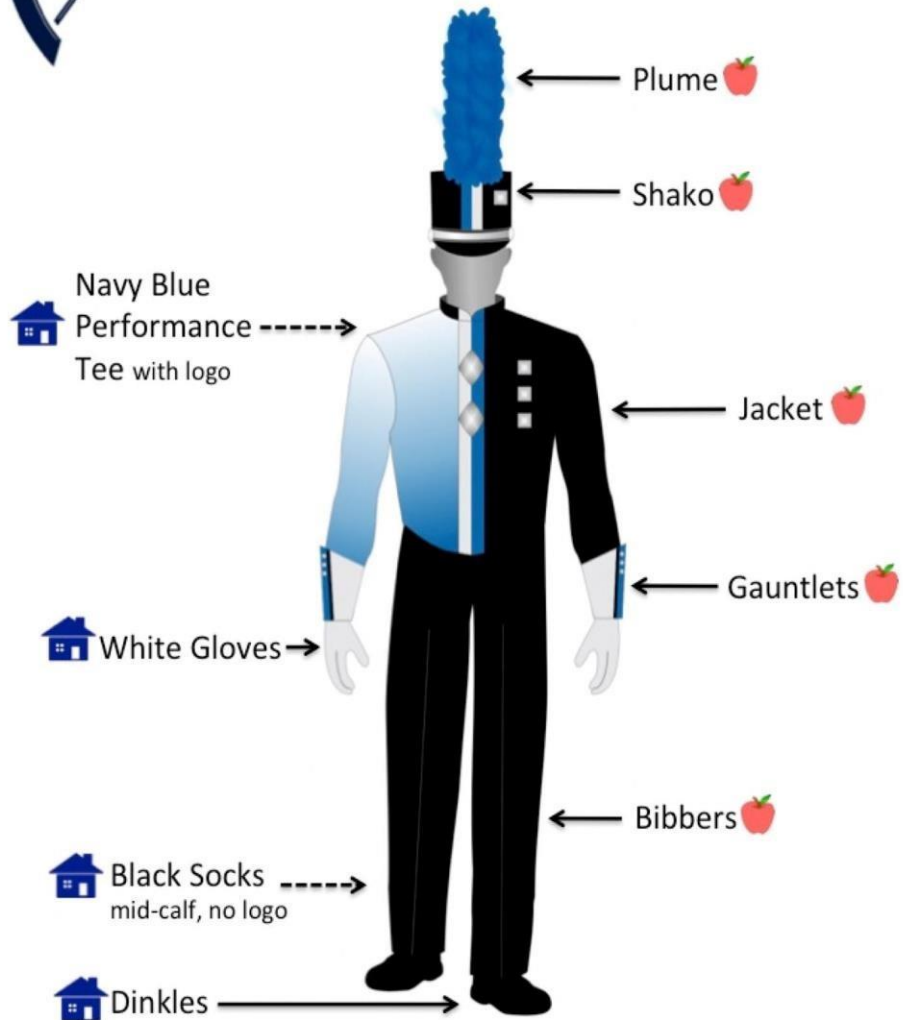
